Visual Art and Drama Four Year Course Plan: VAPA freshmen begin with the Art Spectrum. This course contains Ceramics, 3D, Photography and Graphic Arts. Through the Art Spectrum, students have a clear understanding of several disciplines in the Visual and Performing Arts at CKM. VAPA sophomores continue with 2D Art at the intermediate level to build a firm foundation and establish their discipline of choice. VAPA juniors and seniors explore and develop a portfolio within their chosen discipline in Advanced and AP courses. Discipline options include: 3D Art, 2D Art, Ceramics, Theater, Graphic Arts and Photography. This trajectory provides VAPA students with the opportunity to grow and explore through four years of art, an option only available at CK McClatchy High School.
